#### Annual General Meeting - Notice & Proxy Form

Notice is hereby given that the Annual General Meeting (**Meeting**) of Shareholders of Breaker Resources NL (ACN 145 011 178) (the **Company**) will be held at The Celtic Club, 48 Ord Street, West Perth WA 6005 on Thursday, 18 November 2021 at 3.30pm (AWST).

The Company will hold a physical meeting with the appropriate social distancing measures in place to comply with the Federal and State Government's current restrictions for physical gatherings. However, in order to minimise the risk to shareholders and to the Company and its ongoing operations, Shareholders are encouraged to vote by proxy instead of attending the meeting.

In accordance with Treasury Laws Amendment (2021 Measures No. 1) Act 2021, the Company will not be dispatching physical copies of the Notice of Meeting (**NOM**). Any directed proxies that are not voted on a poll at the Meeting will default to the Chair of the Meeting, who is required to vote these proxies as directed. Any undirected proxies that default to the Chair of the Meeting will be voted according to the instructions set out in this Proxy Voting Form, including where the Resolutions are connected directly or indirectly with the remuneration of KMP.

#### STEP 2 - VOTES ON ITEMS OF BUSINESS

All your shares will be voted in accordance with such a direction unless you indicate only a portion of voting rights are to be voted on any item by inserting the percentage or number of shares you wish to vote in the appropriate box or boxes.
